10 **A RESOLUTION**

11 **DIRECTING THE CITY MANAGER TO WORK WITH STAFF TO EXPLORE THE**  
12 **FEASIBILITY, INCLUDING FISCAL IMPACT, OF CREATING A RECREATIONAL**  
13 **VEHICLE DUMP STATION FOR LOCAL RESIDENTS AND TRAVELERS TO OUR**  
14 **CITY.**

16 **WHEREAS**, Santa Fe has many adventurous local residents who own and maintain  
17 recreational vehicles for their own use; and

18 **WHEREAS**, Santa Fe is a desirable vacation destination for many travelers; and

19 **WHEREAS**, many of these travelers choose to travel by recreational vehicle to be able  
20 to visit other cities in route to our city; and

21 **WHEREAS**, recreational vehicles are self-contained and require a means to eliminate  
22 stored waste; and


23 **WHEREAS**, in an effort to provide an environmentally safe means for local residents  
24 and travelers to eliminate the stored waste from their recreational vehicles, the city would need to  
25 provide the services of a dump station.

1           **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE**  
2 **CITY OF SANTA FE** that the City Manager is directed to work with staff to explore the  
3 feasibility of creating a dump station to provide local residents and travelers an environmentally  
4 safe means of eliminating solid waste from their recreational vehicles.


5           **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that staff should include in the analysis, location, cost
