11 **IN SUPPORT OF A COOPERATIVE AGREEMENT EXTENSION WITH THE NEW**
12 **MEXICO DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION FOR THE DEFOURI AND**
13 **GUADALUPE STREET BRIDGE IMPROVEMENTS.**

15 **WHEREAS**, through the adoption of Resolution 2015-67, the Governing Body approved
16 support of a Cooperative Agreement with the New Mexico Department of Transportation (NMDOT)
17 of Project No. MAP-7649(903), CN L500219

18 **WHEREAS**, the funds were for improvements to the Defouri and Guadalupe Street Bridges
19 (“Project”) through the Municipal Arterials Program (MAP) administered by the (NMDOT); and

20 **WHEREAS**, the NMDOT awarded the City of Santa Fe \$80,000 in MAP project funding for
21 Fiscal Year 2015/2016 for the Project and entered into a cooperative project agreement with the
22 NMDOT to receive this funding; and

23 **WHEREAS**, the MAP cooperative agreement, Project No. MAP-7649(903), CN L500219,
24 required a local match of \$26,667 (25%), to NMDOT state share of \$80,000.00 (75%); and


25 **WHEREAS**, an extension of the cooperative agreement to December 31, 2017 is needed for

1 the completion of the Project.

2 **NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE**
3 **CITY OF SANTA FE** that the Governing Body supports the request for extension to December 31,
4 2017 for completion of the Project funded through a MAP cooperative project agreement with the
5 NMDOT.


6 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the City of Santa Fe accepts responsibility for the
7 Project; assumes the lead role in design development and construction of the Project; agrees to the
8 terms, conditions, and certification and reporting requirements of the MAP cooperative project
9 agreement; and assumes ownership, liability and maintenance responsibilities for all amenities related
10 to the completion of the Project.
